Sarah: is it the game where the substitute got a red card?

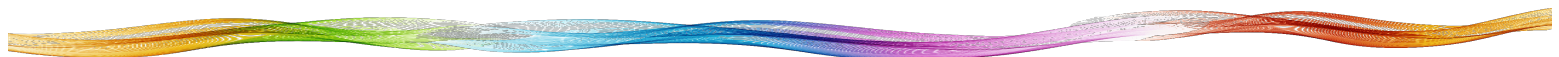
W: Yes it is. But by the way, how come a woman like you is so fond of this men's sport?
