W: Are they?

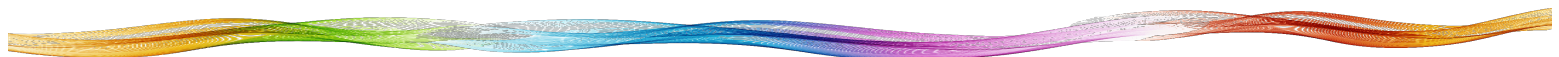
Sarah: of course they are if you show interest to their culture and country! I’ve done couch-surfing all week and I had a great time meeting very nice people each time!
