Grammar :

1 /GET USED TO –ING

We use 'GET USED TO' to express that a person is in the process of doing something 'normal', that an action is becoming a habit. After GET USED TO, we can find a noun or a verb ending in –ING.

A direct equivalent is 'become used to VING'.

Both phrases are commonly used with the present continuous.

The basic pattern is **BE GETTING USED TO + Ving**

Example:

They are getting used to living in the city

I'm becoming used to running

He became used to his intrusive mother-in-law

The children got used to their new room

We will get used to our new life
